# PORTUGAL ESTORIL 6th MAY, 2012



### EXCITEMENT EXPECTED AT ESTORIL

Fast, varied and prone to unsettled conditions, Estoril features many ingredients that make for exciting racing. Combining a top speed of approximately 330km/h along the main straight with heavy braking for the first corner, at Estoril riders are faced with extremely slow sections such as the first gear chicane of turns nine and ten, as well as high-speed turns such as the long and fast final corner, Parabólica.

Due to the variation in the type and speed of corners at Estoril, asymmetric rear

slicks are essential to ensure riders have consistent levels of grip throughout a lap and the necessary durability for a race distance. The left shoulder of the rear tyres is subject to much lower loads and temperature so needs to be softer to offer good warm-up performance and grip from cold, whereas the higher temperatures generated in the right shoulder, particularly as riders open the throttle out of Parabólica and onto the main straight, require a harder compound rubber. Perhaps due to its proximity to the sea, grip levels at

Estoril can vary, while the low average circuit temperatures at the Portuguese circuit require a tendency towards softer rubber compounds, especially for the front tyre.

Due to the variation in the type and speed of corners at Estoril, asymmetric rear slicks are essential to ensure riders have consistent grip throughout a lap and the necessary durability for the race.

TYRE TALK SHINJI AOKI, MANAGER, BRIDGESTONE MOTORSPORT TYRE DEVELOPMENT DIVISION

Estoril has quite a distinctive layout with an imbalance between right and left-hand corners and a combination of fast corners, such as the long, final corner that leads onto the main straight, and very slow sections such as the chicane that makes up turns nine and ten.

The track layout, combined with the generally low track temperatures encountered at Estoril require softer tyre compounds — particularly at the front - to generate the necessary grip and warm-up performance, but for the rear tyre, the right shoulder of the rear tyre needs to be harder to cope

with the high temperatures generated in the last corner. To address this performance requirement, Bridgestone will provide an asymmetric rear tyre at Estoril that features rubber on its right shoulder that is considerably harder than the rubber on the left shoulder for the optimum combination of grip and durability.

### BRIDGESTONE MOTORSPORT ROUND-UP

IndyCar Team Penske's Will Power moved to the top of the IndyCar standings with a second consecutive victory at the Grand Prix of Long Beach in California on April 15. Power expertly managed his set of alternate tyres during a long last stint to take victory ahead of IndyCar rookie Simon Pagenaud in the #77 Schmidt Hamilton Motorsports entry, while Andretti Autosport's James Hinchcliffe rounded out the podium in third. Round 4 of the IndyCar season takes place on the Streets of Sao Paulo in Brazil, after this sheet goes to print.
